| 1. Considerate 關心別人感受的 | Careful not to inconvenience or harm others | She was always considerate of others' needs. |
| 2. Creative 有創意的 | Relating to or involving the use of the imagination or original ideas to create something | Sarah's cooking is very creative: she loves to invent dishes with unusual flavour combinations. |
| 3. Diligent 勤力的 | Having or showing care and conscientiousness in one's work or duties | A diligent worker, Tom stayed late every evening to make sure all tasks were completed fully. |
| 4. Eloquent 口才流利的 | Fluent or persuasive in speaking or writing | His speeches in court were always eloquent and powerful. |
| 5. Generous 慷慨的 | Showing a readiness to give more of something, especially money, than is strictly necessary or expected | Giving your winnings to our charity was so generous – thank you! |

| 6. Intelligent 聰明的 | Having or showing intelligence, especially of a high level | Hardworking and intelligent, George is one of the best students in our class. |
| 7. Levelheaded 果斷的 | Calm and sensible | Despite being shocked and annoyed, he remained levelheaded and thought calmly about what to do next. |
| 8. Optimistic 樂觀的 | Hopeful and confident about the future | I'm optimistic about our chances of winning tomorrow. I know we can do it! |
| 9. Proactive 積極主動的 | creating or controlling a situation rather than just responding to it after it has happened | You need to be proactive about finding an internship – start emailing people and searching online today! |
| 10. Unyielding 不屈的 | not giving way to pressure; hard or solid | He had an unyielding resistance to change. |
